## Insurance

The club is affiliated to British Canoeing (BC), and as such is covered by BC Third Party Insurance whilst on official club activities. If club members are individual members of BC the extent of cover is increased to include Personal Accident as well. For this reason it is strongly recommended that people join BC as individual members, and take out private insurance to cover theft, loss or damage. Individual insurance is not available through the club.
